Registered Psychometrist (RP) Proposal – revised 12/31/09

The RP designation does not include the provision of psychometrist services independent of licensed psychologists. ♣

Registered Psychometrist (RP)

- Minimum Qualifications:
 - BA/BS degree from a regionally accredited college/university [official transcript required]*;
 - Supervision by a licensed psychologist (or certified Canadian psychologist) &/or Certified Specialist in Psychometry (CSP) [attestation required];
 - Minimum of 500 hours test administration and scoring experience in the field of psychometry [attestation required];
 - Uphold the Code of Ethics for Psychometrists (<http://PsychometristCertification.org>);
 - Complete a minimum of 6 CEUs (1 of which must be in ethics) every 2 yrs;
 - Registration fee of \$100 USD – valid for 2 yrs; and
 - Online RP verification listed on the public RP website registry

The RP will be managed by the RP Committee (RPC), an independent subdivision of the Board of Certified Psychometrists (BCP). The RPC will be comprised of BCP members in majority along with non-BCP psychometrists.

The RP is *endorsed/sanctioned/approved/supported/authenticated/?* by NAN – we will need to know how NAN/Div40/AACN, etc. will commit to assist the promotion of the RP.

* - In cases where a psychometrist does not have a bachelor's degree from an accredited academic program there will be a grace period for them to obtain their Registered Psychometrist designation to avoid the possibility of some psychometrists losing their jobs because of this proposal. Psychometrists with less than the BA/BS educational requirement will have one-year (1-year) to apply for the RP designation. One-year after launch of the RP all psychometrists must meet the current RP minimum qualifications.
